


THIS TRUST Deed executed on this 30th day of JUNE 2019 at LAXMI VIHAR BARWALA distt Hissar by Smt. SUDESH CHAHAL W/o Shri VIRENDER SINGH, aged 46 years and resident at H.NO.987 W.NO.12 BARWALA distt Hissar 125121 (Hereinafter referred to as SETTLOR) showith;
Whereas settlor is also the founder is desirous to establish a Charitable Trust by giving a sum of Rs. 1100/- (Rupees One Thousand One Hundred Only) for establishing a Charitable Trust Now by this deed, a trust is hereby established subjects to the following terms and conditions :-

- 1) Name of the Trust shall be M/s "AANCHAL MAA KA EDUCATIONAL CHARITABLE TRUST".
- 2) Registered office of the Trust shall be situated at LAXMI VIHAR, Barwala distt Hissar, Haryana-125121. The office may be shifted to such other place or places as the Board of Trustees may deem it necessary from time to time. Branches/ administrative offices can be opened in any part of the Country for the smooth functioning of the Trust.
- 3) The SETTLOR hereby convey the sum of INR 1100/- (Rupees One Thousand One Hundred only) at the time of establishing of this trust to the following trustees of this trust:-
 - i) Smt. Sudesh chahal W/o VIRENDER SINGH aged 46 years, residing at Aanchal Maa Ka Educational Charitable Trust W.NO. 12, Barwala, Distt Hissar 125121
 - ii) Sh. VIRENDER SINGH S/o DHOOP SINGH aged 49 years, residing at H.NO.987,W.NO. 12, Barwala, Distt Hissar 125121

iii) DHOOP SINGH S/o Sh. RANJIT SINGH R/o VPIO BAYANA KHERA Distt Hissar 125121

4) The property held under trust wholly for charitable purposes of this trust will include

- i. The aforesaid sum of Rs.1100/-
- ii. Such voluntary contributions, corpus funds, gifts, donations from public at large, from any other trust, society, institution, organization, foundation, aids and grant from Government and Government agencies etc. for the purposes of advancing and implementation of the objects and purposes of this trust, even on the condition of necessary of naming building halls etc after the donor.
- iii. Any surplus, accumulations, addition and acquisition that may be made by trustees of this trust.
- iv. Interest, dividend and rental income of the trust.
- v. All movable & immovable Property received by the trust.

5) That the objectives of the Trust shall be "WELFARE OF HUMANITY AND EDUCATION" wholly for the public and charitable purposes and incomes shall be applied for the same and accumulated in India wholly for public & charitable purposes without prejudice to generally of provisions aforesaid and the following shall be deemed to be the objectives of M/S ANANGHAL MAA KA EDUCATIONAL CHARITABLE TRUST

- To co-ordinate any activities related with development of welfare for the cow & its progeny.
- To campaign work in the field of Gau Raksha, Gau Samvardhan & Gau Plan;

- To arrange and provide medical aid and other assistance necessary for living to the needy people who are incapable or handicapped or mentally/physically retarded and financially unfit.

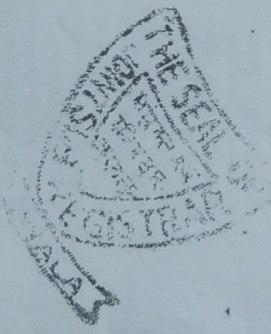

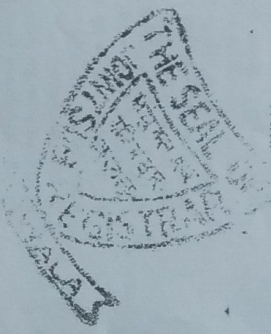

- To work with special concentration for the child, youth & women welfare;
- To grant, pay or give scholarships, prizes, rewards, fellowships and other forms of financial assistance help in cash or kind to the needy and deserving students for pursuing education, vocational training, skill development etc.
- To aware the poor section of our society about the importance of education in today's scenario and the opportunities it provides for a better future.
- To construct and run schools, colleges, and educational institutions for the benefit of the public.
- To grant financial assistance to any educational institution for granting scholarships, prizes, medals, awards for excellence in studies, sports and scientific research, distribution of books and note books for poor and or deserving students.
- To provide necessary facilities or to contribute to educational and scientific research development in any place as the trust finds deemed fit.
- To organize and take up Health, Educational and Social welfare Programs for needy persons.
- To carry out any other activities with the intention of service but not of any profit making.
- To print, publish, purchase, sell, circulate, distribute or exhibit either free or for a price books, periodicals, journals, booklets, bulletins, calendars, message-cards, other literature, films, documentaries, records, paintings and photographs which will assist or promote the objects of the Trust.
- To purchase, sell or otherwise distribute materials and services in the furtherance of the objectives of the Trust.
- To establish Training Centre and allied educational institutions to assist or promote the objects of the Trust.
- To raise funds through donations and contributions to support all the above activities, and setting up appropriate management structure, including subsidiary units as necessary.
- To create assets and transport facilities to accommodate any of the above activities.
- To conduct research studies on the social and economic conditions of people with a view to involving ways and means for their development in their social historical frame works and to seek promotion of rural development such as provision of drinking water rural industrialization as well as Public Convenience for people.
- To organize, conduct, accomplish, manage or carrying out both indoor and outdoor activities in relation to Corporate Social Responsibilities (CSR) obligations to be fulfilled by the body corporate registered under the Companies Act, 2013 corresponding to main objective of the Trust;
- To obtain various research and survey on public.

All the incomes, earnings, movable / immovable properties of the trust shall be solely utilized and applied towards the promotion of its aims and object only a set forth in the Memorandum of the trust and no profit, thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividends, bonus, profits or in any other manner whatsoever to the present or past members of the trust or to any person claiming through any one or more of the present or the past members.

No member of the trust shall have any personal claim on any moveable or immovable properties of the trust or make any profits, whatsoever, by virtue of this membership.

7) Trust established by the settler shall be irrevocable.

8) Funds, surplus and income of the trust shall be solely utilized/ applied towards achievement

of the aforesaid charitable objects of this trust and no portion whereof shall be utilized or distributed amongst trustees directly or indirectly.

- 9) a) Trustees of the trust shall be entitled to co-opt more persons as trustees as may be considered necessary by them for attainment of objects of this trust and for efficient management of this trust. However the total number of trustees shall not exceed 15 at any point of time.
b) Tenure of the office bearers of this trust shall be for 3 years. Trustees of the trust shall elect amongst them, all the aforesaid office bearers for a term of 3 years. Well in advance and till election is held, the office bearers shall continue.
d) Any trustee shall be eligible to be re-elected for same post in ensuring election
e) A Governing Body may be constituted to look after the various institutions of the trust and authorizing them to take such decision for the proper management and day to day working of the institution and to authorize to open and operate the same with financial limitation in this regard.

10) Any trustee shall cease to be the trustee in any of the following eventualities:-

- A) on his death
- B) on the acceptance of his resignation by other trustees.
- C) on his becoming insane and insolvent
- D) on his found to be guilty of an offence and/or moral turpitude by competent Court of law.
- E) on his being expelled by the board of Trustees for his acting or having acted against the interests of the Trust by a majority vote. Provided such trustees have been given a reasonable opportunity of explaining his conduct to the Board of Trustees.

11) Powers, Duties and Function of:

- A) President:
 - 1) To preside meetings of the trust
 - 2) To issue instructions/direction to the Secretary to call meeting of the trust.
 - 3) To execute and sign document(s) relating to trust.
 - 4) To cast additional vote in case of equality of voters of trustees on an issue.
- B) Vice-President: In the absence of president to act as President and to perform all such acts as are assigned by President.

12) The Board of Trustees shall be empowered to assign work of trust to a trustee as Manager and determine his powers, duties, function and terms and conditions and shall be empowered to determine the Powers, Duties, Functions and other terms of the Trust. The President, Vice-President, Secretary, Joint Secretary and Treasurer of the Trust. The Board of Trustees shall be empowered to add into, to vary, modify and alter the same.

13) With a view to carry out the objects of the Trust herein above mentioned and to manage and administrator the Trust funds and without prejudice to the generality of any powers hereby or by law conferred or implied or vested in the Board of Trustees, the Board of Trustees shall have the following powers:-

To apply and use the income of trust and trust funds, surplus and ^{Residual} ~~Residual~~ portion for all or any of the objects of the Trust and/or to accumulate the surplus and ^{Residual} ~~Residual~~ portion of income and invest the same, subjects to the provisions of the income Tax Act, 1961, as amended from time to time, relating to accumulation of income and investment thereof. - b) To receive any money or other assets in any shape or form as gift or donation. Aid and grants and to hold the same as Capital Fund and/or to apply it for furthering the objects of this trust.
- c) To invest the funds from time to time in such as manner as may be decided upon by the trustees from time to time. to dispose of , alter or vary the Investments from time to time, to realize the Investments in conformity with the provisions of the Income Tax Act, 196.
- d) To compromise, compound, abandon, submit to arbitration or otherwise institute any actions, suits, proceeding, claims of other acts and/or things. Whatsoever, arising out of the administrations of the Trust Fund. And to enter into, give, execute and do such agreements, release and other things as may be deemed to be expedient, without being liable or responsible for any loss occasioned by any act or thing so done by them in good faith.
- e) To acquire or to dispose of by any of the recognized mode of convincing movable or immovable, tangible or intangible properties and rights and benefits and to manage the same and to raise construction thereon for attainment of objects of this trust.
- f) To receive, collect or realize and/or cause collection or realization of all income that has accrued or become due on all or any investments and to grant receipts and to grant receipts and discharges relating to same.
- g) To represent this Trust in all Courts (Original and appellate) or before judicial or quasi-judicial authorities and other statutory authorities, departments of Government, Semi-Government or local authority.
- h) To sign and verify all returns , required information , pleadings, memoranda of appeal, petitions and applications of all sorts, and to engage lawyers, Advocates, Chartered Accountants and other professionals and to take all such other necessary steps connected therewith to defend the title of the properties and movable and other properties held by the trust.
- i) To borrow or raise any money that may be required by the Trust for carrying on its activities and for attaining objects, upon such term as may be deemed fit and to secure any money so borrowed by mortgage or charge of all or any part of the assets belonging to the Trust.
- j) To open and maintain accounts with Scheduled and any other Banks(s) and authorize operations of such accounts by any of the members of the Board of Trustees jointly or severally and to draw, accept, endorse, discount and/or negotiate negotiable and quasi-negotiable instruments on behalf of the Trust.
- k) To pay out of the Trust funds, salaries, wages, rent, building maintenance, repairs, fees and other expenses relating to the Trust, its administration, management of its affairs, fees and other expenses relating to the Trust, its administration, management of its activities or its other affairs.
- l) To appoint and/or dismiss staff, executives, officials, caretakers, attendants and other employees on such terms as the Board may think fit.
- m) To appoint Committee or Sub-Committee from among the trustees of the Board of Trustees and/or along with others Philanthropists and to assign duties to them and to frame rules in this behalf.
- n) To undertake and carry on any such other work which may be deemed by the Board of Trustees, capable of being conveniently carried on, in connection with, or calculated, directly or indirectly, to help in the achievement and promotion of the objects and activities of the Trust.
- o) To decide all questions arising in the administration of Trust and including all

p) The Board of Trustees shall conduct the activities of the Trust in accordance with the stipulations set out herein. The Board of Trustees may delegate all or any of the powers vested in them to such person(s) for such period as they may deem fit and may at any time revoke, vary, alter, rescind such powers so delegated.

q) The Trustees have power to frame such Bye Laws, Subsidiary Rules and Regulations and shall have further power to add, delete or amend the same from time to time as may be necessary for the conduct of their business provided that the rules and regulations so framed and the amendments to effect are not inconsistent with the objects of the Trust and also the provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961, governing Charitable Trusts.

r) To do all other acts, deeds, matters and things which may be deemed necessary for carrying out the objects of this Trust or its administration.

14) The official year of the Trust shall be the financial year.

15) All funds, surplus and income of this trust shall be kept in banks and the bank accounts of this Trust shall jointly be operated by Treasurer and any one of the President or Secretary of this Trust.

16) All properties of this trust shall vest in Board of Trustees and shall be represented by the President or Secretary of this Trust.

17) The Trustees shall meet as often as may be considered necessary by them, to transact the business of the Trust. There shall at least be two meetings of the Trustees in a year.

17.1) all decisions of the Board of Trustees shall be taken on the basis of majority votes. In the case of equality of votes, the President and/or Chairman of the meeting shall exercise a casting vote.

17.2) the quorum for a meeting shall be 4. If there is no quorum, the meeting could be adjourned and the requirement of quorum shall not apply for such adjourned meeting.

17.3) It shall be open to the Board of Trustees to adopt any Resolution by circulating the same among the Trustees, provided such a Resolution is assented to by a majority of the Trustees.

All the Resolutions adopted by circulation shall be placed in the immediately next meeting of the Board of Trustees for recording the same.
